Hampshire First Response with e-learning

The Hampshire course comprises of the following parts:

 E-learning (2.5 hours) which teaches all the relevant information including videos, fact sheets and quizzes. On completion of the course, you will be required to complete a form which I will be able to access before attendance at the Zoom confirmation of learning session

Then:

- Zoom session (2.5 hours) this comprises different activities to validate the learning including a multiple-choice quiz & extension questions, scenarios, break out discussions & walking debate. This ensures that the learning is assessed via a trainer led session. This session can also be delivered face to face using the same training materials and will include Module 10B
- Module 10B Practical session (15-30 mins) to complete the practical skills (Assessment of unconscious casualty, CPR Adult & CPR Child compression only)

External First Aid training and First Response online conversion course

Completed a first aid certificate outside of Scouting? The full First Response syllabus and course requirements can be found on The Scout Association website.



If the course does not cover an element of the syllabus this can be rectified by completing one of the short elearning modules (provided by Hampshire Scouts). This will cover the remaining topics needed for First Response:

- Emergency First Aid at Work (1 day)
- First Aid at Work (2 or 3 day)
- Child First Aid courses
